#### A View from the Hill



Education is by far the largest item in the lowa state budget, accounting for 56 cents out of every taxpayer dollar spent. The total State aid from the General Fund is estimated to be \$3.418 billion for fiscal year 2022, an increase of \$36.5 million (1.08%) compared to last year.

The first item to be debated yesterday morning in the Iowa Senate was **State Supplemental Aid (SSA).** 

Senate File 269 contains several main funding points. It establishes a 2.40% State percent of growth rate to be applied to the State cost per pupil for fiscal year 2022 of \$155 per pupil. <u>Read more</u>.

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
