2021 Annual Conference Presenters

Joel Fry, Co-founder of TEAM Restoration spoke at our 2014 annual conference on the topic of compassion fatigue in education. The response from our members was incredible. Educators came away recognizing their own personal struggles had a name! Others recognized peers who possibly were struggling with the issue.

Joel will walk us through what compassion fatigue looks like; who it affects; and engage participants in the exploration of their own levels of compassion fatigue.

Barb Ranck, a certified Enneagram Coach, will help us understand why people react differently to the same situation. Participants will become more aware of why we react the way we do, and why others may react differently.

As participants gain more self-awareness of their own - and others' - triggers, it will ultimately lead to increased compassion, personal energy, and improved collaboration.

PEI Leadership Seminar - August 7, 2021

We currently have two positions open on PEI's Board of Directors. You may vote for two candidates




Jennifer Campbell
