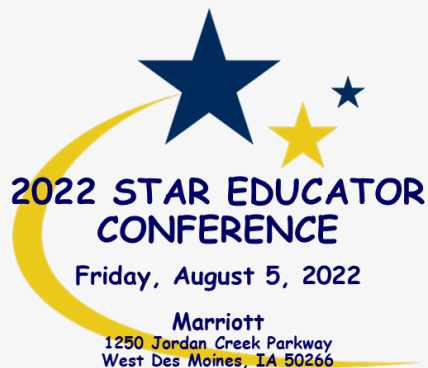

"The skills and tools that are the basis of improvisation make anyone a better communicator, a stronger leader, and a more confident individual. My mission is to bring these skills to you." **Applied Improvisation in the Classroom** will be held **June 13-14 and July 14-15**.

Another new class being offer this summer is **Doubling Down on Dyslexia** with **Elizabeth Hoksbergen**. This class will be held **June 23-24** and will touch on understanding the brain differences of dyslexia, diagnosis and subtypes of dyslexia, key principles of effective intervention (through structured literacy), critical psychological supports, strategic accommodations, leveraging assistive technology, and the power of cultivating strengths.

Also new on our list is **Sweet Solutions for Classroom Implementation of Structured Literacy** taught by **Elizabeth Hoksbergen**. This course will provide participants with a clearly articulated guiding framework for how to teach phonemic awareness, phonics, syllable patterns, morphology, vocabulary, comprehension, and fluency to help every learner to succeed. Class will be held **July 12-13**.

**Dave Dubczak** will be returning once again this summer for **zoom only** classes for **Unlock Your Genius Mode**. In this course, you will learn how to activate your genius mode and how to activate the genius in each of our students through the power of intentional creative thinking! Learn how creativity works, as well as the thought processes and strategies anyone can use to create like geniuses. **Unlock Your Genius Mode** will be held **June 15-16**.

**The Enneagram as a Lens for Understanding Student Behavior** will be taught by **Barb Ranck**, a certified Enneagram coach. These classes provide awareness, education, and resources for educators to identify and appropriately respond to student and peer behaviors they encounter in the classroom. **The Enneagram** class will be held **June 20-21**.
